Brave The Bay on February 12

Brave The Bay is a winter fundraiser benefiting American Cancer Society Relay For Life and is open to skiers and snowshoers. The event will be headquartered at the Baudette VFW on Sunday, February 12 with the race starting at 2:00 p.m. The course starts and ends at the VFW and follows a route not on land, but over the frozen Baudette Bay. **The course will be approximately 3K.** Brave The Bay is a family event and family teams with plastic sleds will be permitted. Children should be closely accompanied by an adult for the duration of the race as there are possible dangers involved due to unpredictable weather and other conditions. Award categories for the race will be: first place male and female skiers, first place male and female snowshoers and first place family. The cost to participate is \$5 per person with a maximum of \$20 per family. A free "Brave The Bay" winter hat will be given to the first 50 to register. After the race a sloppy joe lunch will be available in the VFW for a free-will donation. This event is organized by the LakeWood Nightcawlers Relay For Life Team.
